

## Your very own queens crown

### What you will need-

- Printer
- A4 white cardboard non glossy finish (not too thick as the page needs to be fed through a printer)
- Scissors
- Paper glue or stapler
- Coloured pencils or water colours

### Method-

1. Print the template of the crown, by placing the cardboard/paper into the printer tray, then printing the document making sure to set the printer properties so that the template fits to the paper source, which in this case will be A4.
2. Encourage your child's creativity and by getting her to colour in the crown with either colouring-in pencils or for more of a challenge, try and get her to use water colours or even poster paints..
3. Once the crown has been coloured in or the paint is dry, grab a pair of scissors and cut along the cutting line as indicated in the diagram (moms you might want to get involved here as there could be some tricky corners to cut around)
4. For more sparkle incorporate glitter or embellishments into the design
5. Glue/staple bands '2' and '3' to either side of the main crown, matching up the pattern as you go.
6. Adjust the sides to comfortably fit your child's head, then connect the two bands to complete the crown
